This is in reference to the observations made by the designated team constituted by the Mission Director NHM regarding capacity building and management protocol related to COVID-19, a team of following faculty members/ doctors is hereby constituted to impart hands on training to the concerned Medical and Para-medical staff of various Associated Hospitals designated as Level-2 & Level-3 COVID-19 hospitals:

01. Dr. Mohammad Iqbal Pandith (Associate Professor, Social & Preventive Medicine department, GMC Srinagar) Nodal Officer COVID trainings.

02. Dr. Danish Zahoor (Assistant Professor, Department of Microbiology), GMC Srinagar.

03. Dr. Sanam (Demonstrator, Department of Microbiology), GMC Srinagar.

The teams shall impart trainings in various Associated Hospitals in coordination with concerned Heads of Department & Medical Superintendents in respective hospitals on aspects of capacity building which include training of all personnel on COVID-19 management, staff training on sample collection, packaging, storage and transportation, training of doctors, nurses and support staff on infection prevention and control (IPC), disinfection of Oxygen cylinders, donning and doffing of PPE's, handling of dead bodies/ mortuary etc.

The Medical Superintendents shall ensure audio visual support for the training and adequate seating arrangements while maintaining physical distancing and other infection control measures.

The matter may be treated as most urgent.
