As already notified that Government Medical College is conducting an MCQ type of Examination for Selection of Junior residents on 24-04-2023. This examination consists of 60 MCQ type of questions. Each Question is of one mark (5 points). Each question has four options (A, B, C and D). Candidates are advised to Tick the most appropriate option with blue point ball pen clearly without overlap. Candidates are directed to sign and write down their Roll number on each page of the Answer booklet.

- 1. The rank of the candidates will be decided by the score obtained in this MCQ type of Examination.
- 2. In case two or more than two candidates are having the same score in MCQ type examination, then the merit obtained by each candidate in Final year MBBS will be taken into account. The candidate/candidates scoring higher percentage of marks in Final year MBBS shall be treated higher in the rank for the purpose of selection as Junior Resident.
- 3. If the rank of two candidates remains same even after considering the percentage of merit obtained in MCQ type examination and Final year MBBS examination, then the rank of these candidates shall be decided by taking into account Percentage of marks obtained by each candidate in all MBBS examinations. Candidates having higher percentage of marks in all MBBS examinations will be considered higher in the rank.
- 4. Candidates are advised to report to the allotted examination Centre 30 minutes prior to the start of examination along with admit card and valid proof of Identity.
- 5. No candidate will be allowed to enter examination Centre after start of examination.
- 6. Use of Electronic gadgets like mobile phones and pagers is not allowed.
- 7. Use of unfair means shall lead to disqualification of the candidate.
- 8. No candidate will be allowed to leave examination hall before half of the allotted time is over i.e. 30 minutes after start of examination.
