

Subject: Meeting regarding "Observation of the 8th International Day of Yoga (IDY-2022) on 21st June 2022" in UT of Jammu and Kashmir.

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Shri Manoj Kumar Dwivedi, IAS Principal Secretary to Government, Health and Medical Education Department at Civil Secretariat Srinagar in the committee Room 4th floor on 17th of June, 2022, wherein the following officer participated:

At the outset the Principal Secretary, H&ME department welcomed all the officers who were present in the meeting and those who were participating through video conferencing from different District headquarters. The meeting was informed that the following iconic sites have been identified for celebration of the IDY-2022:-

- (II) Martand Sun Temple Anantnag.
- (III) Suchetgarh Border, Jammu.

Apart from above iconic places IDY-2022 will be celebrated in all the District Headquarters of J&K.

A power point presentation was made by Choudhary M. Yasin, IAS, MD, NHM, J&K regarding the various logistical arrangement for conducting the event at Martand Sun Temple event at Anantnag. The Principal Secretary, Health & Medical Education, J&K emphasized the importance of the event as being connected to the health and well being of all the citizens of this country besides being one of the flagship issues of the Hon'ble PM of India. Stress was laid for conducting of successful events throughout the UT of J&K and seeks maximum participation of public from various fields of life. It was also highlighted that for the safe and successful conduction of the events coordinated efforts from all the stakeholders are needed.

The Director AYUSH, J&K highlighted the issues related to the conduction of the event at Suchetgarh Jammu which have been already finalized in a meeting held on 15.06.2022 at Jammu under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, Ministry of Science and Technology, GoI. The District Administration Jammu who were present in the above said meeting also informed about the various logistical arrangements made for the event and the coordination between different departments. The Principal Secretary, Health & Medical Education Department also issued certain directions for the smooth conduction of the event.

It was further discussed that to ensure maximum participation officers need to be nominated as Nodal officers for ensuring maximum participation and registration for the event through the portal <http://yogaregistration.nic.in/idy/2022/>. Emphasis was laid for ensuring the publicity of the event through print electronic and social media.

It was also felt necessary to seek necessary approval from the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor's Secretariat wherever necessary for media and other related issues. The need for nominating senior officers for the three events was also felt necessary for smooth conduction of the event.

2. The Additional District Development Commissioners of District Srinagar, Anantnag and Jammu were nominated as Nodal officers for ensuring that all the participants are registered on the portal <http://yogaregistration.nic.in/idy/2022/>. The participants will then download "bhuvan" mobile application for geo-tagging for participation in IDY-2022.
3. The Director Information, J&K along with concerned District Information officers shall ensure maximum publicity to the events through print electronic and social media platforms before and on the day of events. At the level of Administrative Department of H&ME, the Dr. Shafqat Khan, OSD (H&ME) shall coordinate this activity.
4. The District Administration of Jammu, Srinagar and Anantnag shall ensure smooth transportation, potable drinking water and other facilities for the participants. He was reported that the

participants for the event at SKICC Srinagar shall be transported to the venue by the Directorate of Rural Development Department Kashmir.

5. Live streaming of the events including SKICC shall be made through high speed internet/broadband by the NIC and BSNL authorities in a coordinated manner. The District Administration shall be responsible for ensuring the coordination between the agencies monitoring the event.
6. The videos of the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) adopted worldwide to celebrate IDY-2022 are available on official website of Directorate of AYUSH, J&K viz www.jkdism.in for perusal of general public.
7. Audio/videos messages of the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Chief Secretary, Administrative Secretary H&ME Deptt and Director AYUSH pertaining to the celebration of the IDY-2022 for mass participation of general public shall be got recorded by the Information Department and broadcast/telecast through electronic and social media.
